This will be achieved by providing technical business assistance and community education, managing an economic development loan and grant program, and collaborating with local, regional, state, and national planning and community investment organizations.

- Expand technical assistance to serve a wider range of businesses.

Enhance support for businesses and entrepreneurs

- · Strengthen support for businesses and entrepreneurs and focus on maximizing their success.
- Increase opportunities for these individuals to engage with CEDC and one another through networking events, workshops and additional opportunities offered by partnering organizations.

Make capital investments that help break down barriers that impact rural communities

- Focus capital investments (loans, grants) on core areas that can enhance our primary industries and address infrastructure issues that may be inhibiting our growth.
